Canadian Junior Shorthorn Association (CJSA) 2020 Virtual Show Rules and Regulations

The Canadian Junior Shorthorn Association is proud to give our juniors the opportunity to show off their accomplishments this year in a virtual way.

1. Entry is free but juniors must register as a Canadian Junior Shorthorn Association member before August 12, 2020 (\$25 + HST/GST). Email registry@canadianshorthorn.com or call the CSA registry at 403-717-2581 to purchase your membership.
2. Each member must choose to participate either **in all or two out of the three activities** listed below:
 - a. Conformation Show
 - b. Photography Competition
 - c. Marketing Competition
3. Each member will send a completed entry form via email to cjsanationalshow@gmail.com which will include the activities they have chosen to participate in. Entries will be open from July 12 until August 12, 2020, with photos, videos and marketing submissions due no later than August 16, 2020.
4. After entries are received, members will be provided with a participant number(s) which must be included with photography and marketing submissions, as well as worn in a show harness for the conformation video(s).
5. Each member that participates in the show will be entered into a draw for travel assistance (up to \$500) to attend either the 2021 Shorthorn Junior Forum in Calgary, AB in January or the National Junior Shorthorn Show in Neepawa, MB in July/August as well as other prizes.
6. Videos, photography and marketing submissions must be received no later than August 16, 2020 → or they will not be viewed or judged.

Conformation Show Rules

1. Each member is allowed to participate in our virtual show with up to a total of 10 animals. All animals must be duly registered with the Canadian Shorthorn Association by August 12, 2020 (pending registrations are not allowed).
2. Each member is allowed to participate in our virtual show with up to three animals in each class.
3. Members are allowed to enter any animal: owned, family owned or borrowed.
4. Classes include:
 - Class 1. Purebred Shorthorn Heifer calves
 - Class 2. Purebred Shorthorn Yearling Heifer
 - Class 3. Purebred Shorthorn Cow/Calf Pairs
 - Class 4. Purebred Shorthorn Bull Calves
 - Class 5. Purebred Shorthorn Yearling Bulls
 - Class 6. Shorthorn Plus Heifer Calves
 - Class 7. Shorthorn Plus Yearling Heifers
 - Class 8. Shorthorn Plus Bull Calves
5. Classes may be split, depending on the number of entries.
6. The show is BLOW and GO only. NO fitting is allowed.

7. Members participating in the conformation show must wear a show harness with the show number in the front, to ensure the judge can identify the animal by the show number. The member who enters the animal, must be the individual showing the animal. (A mock show video to will be posted to show what exactly is required, but there must be a clear view of the animal walking head on with the camera, and a view of both the show side and non-show side, along with the rear end and from the rear forward up the back.)
8. Instructions on how to send in the video(s) of animal(s) will be sent out after entries are received. Members must also submit a photo of each animal entered, and the photo file name must be the same as the name of the animal.
9. The CJSA board has the right to decide upon any point not covered by these rules.

Photography Competition:

1. Members are to take a pasture picture with a Shorthorn(s) present in the photo.
2. Pictures will then need to be emailed to cjsanationalshow@gmail.com along with the entrant's full name and participant number.
3. There will be four age divisions – peewee, junior, intermediate and senior.
4. Only one photography entry is allowed per member.

Marketing Competition:

1. There will be four age divisions – peewee, junior, intermediate and senior.
2. Peewee members will pick a costume (fun hat, Halloween costume, cool glasses, whatever they may choose) and dress themselves and/or their animal of choosing. They will then get a picture taken of themselves and their animal, add their name to the photo and submit it to cjsanationalshow@gmail.com.
3. Junior, intermediate and senior members will produce a one-page advertisement electronically, selling an animal(s) of their choice. Ads are to be emailed to cjsanationalshow@gmail.com in PDF or jpeg format.
4. Only one marketing entry is allowed per member.
